



SHARIAH CERTIFICATE FOR ZAKAT FUNDS OF KARACHI RELIEF TRUST

1. Introduction

Karachi Relief Trust (KRT) is a disaster-management voluntary organization established in 2007 in response to Cyclone Yemyin, which caused widespread devastation in Sindh and Balochistan. Formed by a group of civic-minded volunteers, KRT operates on the belief that individuals can make a meaningful impact on society.

Since its inception, KRT volunteers have actively coordinated donation drives, arranged emergency rations, transported relief goods, and participated in rebuilding homes and rehabilitating affected communities. Over the years, KRT has continued to expand its humanitarian services across Pakistan.

2. Method of Utilization of Zakat

KRT's operational and project-related financial needs are met through General Donations and Zakat Contributions. The Zakat funds received from individuals, corporates, and institutions are utilized strictly for the benefits and expenses of eligible beneficiaries.

3. Observation

During the review period, it was noted that:

Total Zakat received amounted to PKR 266,981, which is significantly low compared to:

The total welfare and relief expenditure of approximately PKR 132 million for the relevant project cycle.

Although the low Zakat inflow does not hinder Shariah compliance. But to further strengthen Zakat governance and transparency, it is recommended that:

KRT must clearly identify, tag, and record each incoming donation as either:

- a) Zakat funds, or
- b) General/Other donations

Proper supporting documentation (donor directives, receipts, fund categorization) should be maintained to ensure full traceability.



4. Shariah Ruling / Approval

The undersigned Shariah advisory firm has been appointed as an independent Zakat Consultant to evaluate Karachi Relief Trust's Zakat policies, processes, documentation, and utilization framework.

After conducting a detailed review, we confirm that Karachi Relief Trust collects, manages, and utilizes Zakat funds in accordance with the principles of Shariah, and the Zakat disbursement during the reviewed period aligns with the rules and regulations governing Zakat under Islamic jurisprudence.

This approval is granted based on the information, documents, and procedures reviewed during the audit period. Continued compliance is subject to adherence to the recommendations mentioned above and to periodic Shariah reviews.
